SILVERTON - Allan went to his heavenly home on August 20, 2007 after a brief battle with pancreatic cancer.

Allan was born in St. Cloud, Minn., on March 3, 1940 to Harry and Katie (Abrahamson) Renback. They moved to Silverton in 1947. He graduated from Silverton Union High School in 1958. He lettered in football, basketball and track all four years at Silverton High School. He was on the 1957 District Championship football team that went on to place second in state. coffee with his classmates. He was a longtime member of Immanuel Lutheran Church in Silverton, where he served on various boards.
