Judy Schmidt Lifetime Achievement **Award Presented to Mason Branstetter**

In 1996, the Silverton High School Alumni Association decided to award its first scholarship. Association founder and longtime secretary Mason Branstetter, SHS '63, recalled it was a quite humble beginning.

"Given the fact that we only had \$900, we thought that we could only give out \$50," Branstetter said. "We established a policy of putting our emphasis on growing the principal and giving out only earnings as scholarships. I was embarrassed with the \$50 amount, so I added a matching donation so that our first scholarship in 1996 we \$100."

More than 20 years later, it is a different story. In 2016, the SHSAA awarded more than \$65,000 in scholarships.

"Since 1996, we have awarded \$734,300 to 957 SHS alumni while growing our investment principal from \$100 to \$1,050,000", Branstetter said.

The growth and impact of the alumni association's scholarship program over the past two decades is amazing. It also makes Mason Branstetter a more than worthy recipient of the Judy Schmidt Lifetime Achievement Award from the Silverton Chamber of Commerce.

Among those nominating Branstetter for the award was David McColly, who wrote, "Without Mason, I don't think this (scholarship) program would exist."

Noting the contributions of time, money, materials, office space and office staff help that Branstetter provides through Silverton Realty, Jeanette and Stanley Olafson concurred that, "None of this would be possible without Mason's help."

The December 2013 issue of the Silverton Alumni News featured an article on the SHSAA reaching its "Million Dollar Goal," and noted, "Collectively, we can now boast that we have one of the strongest high school alumni associations in the state ..."

Branstetter, who seems reluctant to claim much credit for the group's success, says, "The SHSAA has been tremendously successful because of a team of dedicated SHS alumni."

That team was not in place in 1993 when the 30th reunion of the SHS Class of 1963 was held. Reunion organizers, including Branstetter, had \$900 left over after expenses and wanted to use it for the benefit of the high school, but realized the funds would not go far. They decided to put the money aside for scholarships. Branstetter admitted progress was slow at first because "there were only three members of the Alumni Association - me, myself, and I.

"Around 1996 the Silverton 'rumor mill' went to work, some fellow SHS Alumni approached

me, and we really started getting something accomplished to establish and grow the SHSAA. This proves that it takes a team to get things done. As we gained more members of the board of trustees, they volunteered and assumed individually and collectively the responsibilities for the many necessary functions and positions to make a successful organization. The SHSAA organization started its phenomenal growth."

As someone with a long and distinguished military career, first in the Oregon National Guard and then the U.S. Army, Branstetter was well-acquainted with building a team, as well as planning, organizing and implementing the plan. He found the SHSAA helped him continue his deep commitment to service in civilian life. "(One thing) most military retirees talk about is living in an environment that lacks a sense of brotherhood and duty," he said. "The SHSAA has helped fulfill that need."

Mason has been married to Marcia Brooks Branstetter, a fourth-generation native Oregonian, for 49 years. The couple, who have four children and 12 grandchildren, returned to Silverton in 1989 after Mason completed 26 years of military service, which involved 16 moves in 22 years. Branstetter said their moves were good preparation for the couple eventually purchasing Silverton Realty.


Solar Eclipse Coming Aug. 21, 2017

By SHS High School Journalism Team: Author Isabelle Doan '18 Photographer Ben Amsden '18 Editor Amelia Underhill '19 In the small town of Silverton, Oregon, an even smaller team of 25 high school students and four teachers have come together in the name of science. At Silverton High School, this team prepares for a once in a lifetime opportunity: the chance to see and film a solar eclipse. Silverton High is one of only seven high schools in the United States that are able to piece together a "package" containing everything that's needed to record data of the total solar eclipse pass-

A total solar eclipse is a type of eclipse that occurs when the Moon is in perfect alignment with the Earth, causing the Moon to cast a shadow of itself onto the Earth's surface.

ing over Silverton and the rest of

the United States on August 21st.



The solar eclipse being visible in the United States is pretty phenomenal, but that's not the best part; the total solar eclipse will be visible from the West Coast to the East Coast, but only in specific areas, so lucky towns like Silverton can get some recognition.

There are only 55 teams in the U.S. that are able to record data

with the materials that NASA has given them. Some of these teams are college teams, some are high school. Most of these teams have already done test launches, and Silverton is making an impact with their building and launching skills.

On the day of the official launch, August 21st, the camera attached to the balloon being sent up 100,000 feet into the air - which is nearly three times the height airplanes are allowed to fly - will film the

solar eclipse live, send the data back to the Silverton High students, and then on to NASA. With this data, NASA plans to create live-streamed footage of the total solar eclipse, which will be located on their website during the day of the eclipse.

Today, on April 15th, the build team is focusing on the cut down timer that will release the package, which contains the camera collecting data with the modem, the tracker, the cut down component sensor, and the secondary cut down. This team has run into some issues concerning the communication between the camera and the satel-

lite, which they are attempting to fix through analyzing their process of putting the two together to catch their error. This process in any science experiment is crucial in finding and correcting errors, allowing for a smooth execution of collecting data



OSU LBCC working on the communications between the camera and the satellite. Levi Willmeth graciously joined Silverton's NASA team on April 15th to help the build team understand errors that were made, as well as to give the Launch and Journalism team constructive advice.

Silverton HAB is making phenomenal progress in understanding "what to do next." The launch team is focusing solely on getting the tracker up and running in order to find all of the equipment used on the day of the launch. The launch team is doing this by sending the tracker 150 feet into the air -- April 15th -- using giant balloons shaped like Peppa the Pig, Baymax, and other friendly characters.

Below, the balloons and the launch team are visible, working on the step by step process of properly testing the tracker without losing it. Some sources of error considered included wind speed, weight of sensor, string type, environment -- were there trees in the way? -- and grasp of string. Some of these errors occurred and caused a slight setback, but that's the whole purpose of trial and error: to fix any sort of problem thrown in the way.

Below, junior Carolina Gaspar (a member of the launch team) is seen learning the functions of the tracker and how to get it up and running. The tracker is crucial in the procedure of launching the camera, because when the cut down timer cuts the package from the balloon, the chase team will need to know where to find it. The tracker will also collect what is seen when and where
