## Support Scholarships with IRA Charitable Rollover

In December 2015, President Obama signed the Protecting Americans from Tax Hikes Act of 2015 into law, which includes a permanent extension of the IRA charitable rollover. The IRA charitable rollover allows taxpayers age 70 1/2 or older to make tax-free charitable gifts of up to \$100,000 per year directly from their Individual Retirement Accounts to eligible charities, like the Silverton High School Alumni Association.

### Here Are the Details:

- You are age 70 1/2 or older at the time of the gift.
- You transfer up to \$100,000 directly from your IRA. This opportunity applies only to IRAs and not other types of retirement plans.
- You transfer the funds outright to one or more qualified charities. Transfers to charitable trusts, donor advised funds, charitable gift annui-

ties or supporting organizations are not permitted.

### Frequently Asked Questions

Q. Can my gift be used as my minimum required distribution under the law?

A. Yes, absolutely. If you have not yet taken your required minimum distribution, the IRA charitable rollover gift can satisfy all or part of that requirement. Contact your IRA custodian to complete the gift.

Q. I'm turning age 70 1/2 in a few months. Can I make this gift now?

A. No. The legislation requires you to reach age 70 1/2 by the date you make the gift.

Q. I have several retirement accounts—some are pensions and some are IRAs. Does it matter which retirement account I use?

A. Yes. Direct rollovers to a qualified charity can only be made from an IRA. Under certain circumstances, however, you may be able

**Honorary Diplomas - 2016**

**Don Kelley**

*Don grew up in Chicago. After receiving his BA from St. Mary's University of Minnesota, he came to Oregon in 1967 to attend graduate school at the University of Oregon. In 1969, he received his M.A. in theater and in 1974 he received his law degree from Willamette University.*

*Don and his wife, Theresa, moved to Silverton in 1972 and he opened his law practice in 1974. All four of their children graduated from Silverton Union High School and they currently have seven grandchildren in Silverton schools. Don strongly believes that the education provided by Silverton schools is unsurpassed.*

*Don is an officer and director of Center Stage, a Silverton-based community theater. In that capacity, he has directed numerous fund raising musicals including three at the new high school auditorium. Over the years, Don has maintained a close connection with the high school including serving on the Mabel Almquist Scholarship board, coaching the high school Moot Court team, helping to judge the FFA speech competition and a state high school acting competition. For three years he served on the Bond Advisory Committee charged*

*with overseeing the use of the bond money in the construction of the new high school. From time to time, he has made presentations in the high school classrooms.*

**Errol and Lucy Eaden Ross**

*Born around the turn of the century, they came to Silverton in the 1930's where Errol became the first Shell Oil Jobber in the State of Oregon. In this capacity, he sold heating oil to residences and supplied a local Shell Service Station on the corner of First and Oak Streets (known as Henjum's Shell) with gasoline and oil products.*

*He was a thrifty business man and was involved in the development of the Eureka Acres subdivision on "West Hill" where a street bears his name today.*

*At the time of his death in 1992, his estate established the funds for what was to be called the Silverton High School Scholarship Fund. After a few years, in an effort to increase the benefits to graduates of SHS, the fund was dissolved and the money transferred to the Alumni Association where it remains today as a major source for annual scholarship awards to both graduating seniors and alumni.*

to roll assets from a pension, profit sharing, 401(k) or 403(b) plan into an IRA and then make the donation. To determine if a rollover to an IRA is available for your plan, speak with your plan administrator.

Q. I have two charities I want to support. Can I give \$100,000 from my IRA to each?

A. No. Under the law, you can give a maximum of \$100,000. For example, you can give each organization \$50,000 this year or any other combination that totals \$100,000 or less. Any amount of more than \$100,000 in one year must be reported as taxable income.

Q. My spouse and I would like to give more than \$100,000. How can we do that?

A. If you have a spouse (as defined by the IRS) who is 70½ or older and has an IRA, he or she can also give up to \$100,000 from his or her IRA.

Please consult with your tax and finance professionals if you are contemplating a charitable gift.

## Phil Clites Scholarship Fund

For those of you that attended Silverton High School from 1947 through 1957, it's quite likely that you crossed trails with the guy that taught algebra, physics and chemistry. He also was an advisor to several classes and the camera club. That guy is still around and active in the Silverton community. Phil Clites, or Mr. Clites for those who still can't call one of your teachers by their first name, just turned ninety in early April.

Following his graduation from Red Oak High School in Red Oak, Iowa in 1943, he attended the University of Wisconsin and earned a Bachelor of Science Degree in Mechanical Engineering. After teaching at Silverton High School from 1947 through 1957, he went to work at the US Bureau of Mines in Albany, Oregon. There he worked on special methods to melt refractory (high melting point) metals until retiring in 1984. From 1989 until last year, he continued to be of valuable service to Silverton High School students by being an exceptional math tutor. His dedication to education and the

countless hours of volunteering as a tutor has been a significant positive influence upon many students over a very long period of time.

In order to honor and thank Phil for his service to SHS students, a special scholarship fund in his name has been established at the SHS Alumni Association. 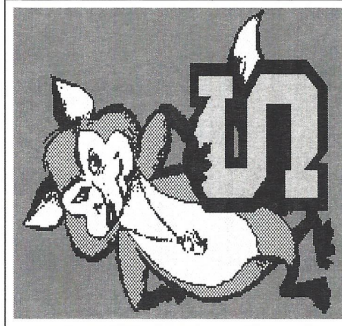

using the money to start an alumni trust, and then build it to the point at which the interest could be used for scholarships."

The trust was established with the Class of '63's \$900, and a gift of \$1,000 from an anonymous alum soon followed. To help the group reach its goal of \$100,000, the SHS Alumni Association was formed. SHS grads can join the association for just \$5 per year.
