

### SHS First Scholarship Awardee Pays it Forward

Recently we received a \$500 donation to our scholarship fund from Emily Wallace Palmer, Class of 1996. Emily was the very first recipient of the SHS Alumni Association scholarship back in 1996. She was awarded \$100 after graduation in 1996.

After graduating from SUHS in 1996, Emily studied Journalism & Communication at the University of Oregon. She specialised in Advertising, competed on Ad Team and sold advertising for the Oregon Daily Emerald, the daily newspaper on campus. While at UO, Emily did internships at Eugene Weekly and The Register-Guard, as well as worked jobs on campus, including Resident Assistant in the dorms.

She tapped into her heritage, choosing to study Swedish and earning a minor in Scandinavian studies. In 1997 she won a Vasasponsored trip to Sweden and has returned many times since, including a trip this June with her mother, Kirsten, around Sweden and Norway.

When Emily graduated in 2000, she moved to San Francisco to work for Saatchi & Saatchi, an advertising agency. In 2001, the burst of the dot com bubble forced the doors of the agency closed and Emily to reevaluate her plans. Leveraging her experience selling advertising in college, Emily went to work for The Examiner and later Contra Costa Newspapers. She tried a year of real estate sales, which wasn't to her liking, despite having been around real estate since her days at Silverton Realty, where she helped out on Saturdays during high school.

In 2006, it was time to focus on new media. Emily went to work in digital advertising, enjoying the innovation of startups and ad tech firms including Kontera (since acquired by Singtel via Amobee) and MediaMind (now Sizmek). In 2011, she got started in programmatic advertising, which leverages technical connections and data to drive efficiencies in advertising, and has been hooked on the fast pace ever since. Since 2014, Emily has been Head of Programmatic, EMEA at Thomson Reuters, leading programmatic advertising strategy and commerce for Reuters.com and news apps. She speaks regularly at industry events.

Emily lives in London with her English husband, Neil, whom she met in San Francisco. Eating delicious food, checking out cool places in East London, travelling and spending time with friends are activities that rank high on her list. To give a bit back to her community, Emily participates in Reading Partners, a weekly reading session with 6 year-olds who benefit from individual attention to improve reading, comprehension and confidence. She sits on the board of a charity, Black Women's Health & Family Support, which provides support and a sense of community, as well as campaigning against FGM.

Thanks to a strong foundation built at SUHS, from honours classes that earned college credits, speech team that gave her an early start on public speaking, and sports and other extracurriculars that taught team work and discipline, Emily is able to handle what life throws at her and also confidently create the life she wants.

Emily is hoping to inspire other scholarship recipients to give back as she has. In addition to her donation, she participated in her company's charitable giving program in which Thomson Reuters matched her donation bringing the total to \$1,000.

We encourage Alumni to check with their employers, as Emily did, to inquire about participating in employer matching charitable giving programs if offered.

## **History of SHS**

Note: The following is a modified version of the article first printed in the June 2007 issue of Silverton Alumni News.

In researching the history of Silverton High School, I was allowed to read a book by Minnie Engeman. She did a fantastic job of documenting all the buildings. The pictures in the display are taken from the book. In order to tell the history of the high school, I felt the grade schools had to be included.

The first Silverton public school was a 2-room, 2-story building started in 1862. There were 96 school age children in the district. About 1889 the pupils overflowed the schoolhouse. The building was sold in 1890 and moved to the corner of Park and First Streets, where the building remained until the land was needed for a high school building in 1907. The 2-story building is still standing, located at High and 3rd Streets, and known as the MWA Hall. Many square dances were held there in the late 40's and early 50's. The building is owned by the Modern Woodworkers Association. In 1890 a six room school building was completed for fall term. The building was named Emerson by

the P.T.A. when they named other school buildings in 1922. In 1907, a six room high school, later named Washington Irving, was erected. 1913-1914 school year the enrollment was 89 for the high school.

According to Minnie Engeman's book, "History of Silverton Public Schools" (new edition 1996), Eugene Field was built affronting North Water Street. Eugene Field School was ready for use in May 1922 according to the historical booklets we have in the district office. The first phase consisted of eight classrooms, the gym, library, office, etc.

In August of 1921, Emerson School was moved to the corner of First and A Street to make room for the construction of Eugene Field School. Emerson School burned to the ground during Christmas vacation in 1924. In 1915 the new high school was erected on First Street between Park and A Streets, next to the Washington Irving Building. This was known to many as the "new high school". In 1916 the school system had an enrollment of 642 students, 145 of which were in the high school. The high school on Schlador Street was built in 1939 for grades 9 through 12. 7th and 8th grades were in the 1915 building,

with grades kindergarten through 6th grade in Eugene Field.

In 1955 Mark Twain replaced the old Junior High (1915 building). Robert Frost school was built in 1971 for grades four to six. For the school year of 2006-07, Eugene Field held grades Kindergarten through third grades, Robert Frost fourth through sixth grades, Mark Twain seventh through eighth grades, the Pine Street Campus for 9th grade freshmen, and Silverton High School grades 10 through 12. The Washington Irving building and the 1915 building were torn down and the First Christian Church occupies that ground today.

In summary, the Washington Irving Building was the first high school. The second one was the 1915 building, which later became the "Junior High" when the Schlador Street high school was built. Who named the schools? Why authors? One theory is that the book "Winkin, Blinkin & Nod" was quite popular when the grade school was built. Eugene Field was the author, so the P.T.A. named the school. Note that all grade schools are named for authors; the high school remains unnamed.

Addendum: More changes have been made this 2016-17 school year. Eugene Field closed in June 2016. Mark Twain now holds grades K-2, Robert Frost grades 3-5. Modular buildings established at Schlador St. hold grades 6-8 and the school is named "Silverton Middle School". Silverton High School is on Pine Street and holds all four years, 9-12.



## Ways to Give to SHS Alumni Association

You may make a life income gift by transferring securities, cash, or other property to SHSAA or a trustee. The SHSAA or trustee then manages the investment of the assets and pays an income to you, your designated beneficiaries, or both. Income payments continue for the beneficiaries' lives or, in some cases, for a term of up to 20 years. Some examples include charitable gift annuities, charitable remainder unitrusts, and charitable remainder annuity trusts.

#### **Other Types of Gifts**

Donors can also establish Charitable Lead Trusts. Unlike the Life Income Gift vehicles, a charitable lead trust makes an annual payment to SHSAA for a period of years, and at the end of the term, the remaining assets go to your children or other beneficiary.

These are just some examples of ways to give. As always, you should consult a tax and legal advisor for the type of gift that best suits your circumstance. You can also contact SHSAA Treasurer, Tracy Duerst, at djduerst@aol.com for more information.
