It was July 2017 when I received an inquiring phone call from a classmate. As Class of '59 class representative he was calling to ask if the Class of '59 needed money for any class projects.

In the past few years the Class of '59 has opted to donate cash, in lieu of an item, for the annual SHSAA silent auction scholarship fundraiser. I asked if he would be willing to send \$59.00 for that year's donation. He readily agreed, also donating more \$\$\$ for our 60th class reunion expenses. Thank You, Gary Kellar!

Upon receiving the \$59.00 I filled out the auction donation form and thought maybe I could challenge other classes to do the same. I contacted our Facebook expert Tracy Duerst and together a challenge on Facebook was posted.

Several classes went right to work posting on Facebook, emailing and contacting classmates via USPS.

When the August 2017 annual fundraiser was held, a total of over \$3,400 had been collected from this simple challenge.

Fast forward to 2018 and word of the challenge was spreading, thanks to some hard work by the class representatives and many individuals. The donations started coming in as early as January 2018. Some were as small as \$5.00, some were as large as \$10,000 and they all added up to a grand total of \$18,430, which was announced at the annual August Scholarship fundraiser.

The Class of 1960 was the winner for 2018 with the largest amount of money collected \$11,445 for the Challenge. A scholarship of \$1,500 will be awarded to a 2019 graduate in the name of the Class of 1960. Other notable class donations are listed on page 7-8. My message to you is that you can donate any amount for the 2019 Challenge to continue to develop perpetual funding for SHS student scholarships.

This simple challenge has been a great winner for the scholarship fund. Any other ideas out there?

Please remember, not only the Class of 1960 for their winning the Challenge (great job), but everyone involved is a winner - students, donors, alumni, community members and many more. Thank you all!

Now, let's get to work and see what your class can do for the scholarship fund in 2019.


