## SHSAA Volunteer of the Year

At the Silverton First Citizen's Banquet in January, Judy Ernst Nunn '60 was honored as the Silverton High School Alumni Association Volunteer of the Year for 2017. Judy joined the Silverton High School Alumni Association in 1998 and with her experience in editing a newsletter for Cooley's Gardens and creating a magazine for the Tall Bearded Iris Society, she was the obvious choice to assume the position of the SHSAA newsletter editor. With her innovative ideas and desire to help reduce the expense of the newsletter, she made changes to the newsletter format that resulted in significant savings on the printing costs. Judy has also implemented a streamlined processes for preparing the printed newsletter for mailing with an assembly line process of volunteers that allows around 3500 newsletters to be ready to mail in less than 2 hours.

In 2001 SHSAA held their first scholarship fundraiser dinner and silent auction at the Oregon Garden in Silverton. Judy worked with Jeanette Olafson, Carmen Smith and Verna Thayer to collect items for the silent auction. She was instrumental in establishing a process of setting up the item bid sheets prior to the auction, taking pictures of each item and printing it on the actual bid sheet. She also creates gift certificates for businesses that don't have pre-printed certificates available. This has been her practice every year since 2002 as she continues to be in charge of the silent auction activity at the annual event.

The annual event continues to raise money each year to award Silverton High School graduates college scholarships.

Judy was elected Vice President in 2004 and after her term she opted to continue as a Trustee. Since 2004 she has remained in that position in addition to her position as Editor of the SHSAA Newsletter, "Silverton Alumni News". The newsletter is published twice a year and sent out in June and December. She maintains a list of those alumnus who have passed away and publishes that list for the period in each newsletter. She also communicates with the class representatives and provides assistance to them in beginning their reunion planning process. This includes providing updated class lists and encouraging articles for the newsletter to communicate reunion plans with classmates. The newsletter is complimentary for alumni in classes that would be holding a reunion in either five or ten year intervals. She maintains the SHSAA database of over 16,000 SHS alumni dating back to the class of 1908 by updating addresses, tracking membership, donations and the deceased to keep the database as current as possible.

Besides the many volunteer hours Judy spends on SHSAA activities, Judy still is involved with creating the magazine for the Tall Bearded Iris Society. She also attends iris conventions, usually one or two each year, to visit with iris friends and take pictures of the iris fields that she needs to help create the magazine. Judy loves to spend

**Dean Craig**

When Dean Craig's parents decided to move from Lake Oswego to Monitor at the end of his fifth grade year, he was devastated and thought it was the worst thing in the world. Little did he know it was the best thing for him. Dean attended Monitor and began his freshman year at Silverton in 1979. Dean played football and wrestled (although only one year for wrestling) and made many lifelong friends from both schools.

On November 11th 1981, during Dean's senior year at SUHS, his first son was born. The two most important things his father taught him were to always work hard and to take responsibility for your actions. Because of this Dean left school and got a job the day Michael was born. He also remembered very well what his dad told him about the importance of education and got his GED some time later. Since then he has set out to learn as much as possible about many topics and has become what many call a "Lifelong learner". His favorite subject to study came as a result of a career move in the mid-1990s when he was promoted to Operations Manager of a manufacturing company in Woodburn. Dean realized the key to a successful business is the people within that business and he wanted to know as much about what makes people "tick" as possible. This led him to be recruited to a staffing agency in Salem called Personnel Source in late 2001. He took the business from approximately \$400K in sales to more than \$3.5 million in five years and increased profits by nearly 60%. This success was a direct result of his study of people and sharing this knowledge with anyone who would listen.

Dean has spent hundreds of hours in the classroom, in any high school that would let him in (including Silverton), to talk about what it takes to be successful in any job. Thousands of students have heard Dean speak on this topic. Many of those student have sought Dean out when they were ready to go to work.

Dean has five children, Michael, Nicholas, Elizabeth, Jacob and Joshua (all of whom graduated from Silverton HS) and seven grandchildren.

Dean's message to everyone is, Work hard to be the best at whatever you do, do it with the integrity as if your grandmother was watching and yearn to learn and never stop, but do so with discernment.

**Rodney E. Orr, MD**

Dr. Orr grew up in Gresham and attended Gresham High School. He received his medical degree from OHSU in 1976, and completed a residency in Family Medicine in Colorado in 1979.

Dr. Orr moved to Silverton in 1979. While attending his first Silverton football game at the invitation of his neighbor Jack Berger, the varsity wrestling coach, he was called to the field to attend to an injury and has not left the sidelines for the last 37 years. He also has consulted with and supported the training staff in the evaluation and treatment of student athletes in all sports.

He established a sports physicals program at the high school with all the proceeds going to the Silver Fox Foundation.

He has been an avid supporter of the Silverton Swim Team and has helped coach girls' softball.

He has been a supporter and volunteer for the Band and chorale music programs.

In 1979 he established Family Medical Group of Silverton with the goal of providing high quality comprehensive care to the Silverton community. Family Medical Group now has locations in Silverton and Molalla with 11 providers, 2 urgent care clinics and almost 40 employees. He regularly has health occupations class students rotate through his office.

Dr. Orr is married to Dr. Shandra Greig and has 4 children, Rebekah, Ashley, Lindsey and Jason, all of whom attended Silverton High School. He is a staunch supporter of public education.
