Star visits Silverton

Howard Hesseman died on January 29, 2022, in Los Angeles at age 81. Howard Hesseman, aka Howard "Butch" Main (Class of 1958), visited Silverton for a social evening at the McClaine Street home of his friend and fellow classmate, Allan Renback.


A trio of SUHS students on the school newspaper attended that event to interview Howard and take some photos. Jeff Marcoe (Class of 1979) was the editor of the Fox's Howl that year and attended that party with his parents, Arnie and Carol Marcoe. Curt Almquist (Class of 1980) took photos and Teri Wiesner wrote up the story.

She also had interviewed him earlier that day by phone when Howard was in Portland doing a radio show.

As a tribute to Howard, we are pleased to reprint the Fox's Howl story about Hesseman's 1978 visit that Teri Wiesner Baker authored back then. Teri offers a look back reflection at the end of this article.

What started out to be a five minute visit with Dr. Johnny Fever (Howard Hesseman) turned out to be a two-and-a-half fun-filled hour with Butch Main.

Butch Main plays a disc jockey on his new comedy series, WKRP in Cincinnati. Main is a SUHS graduate and also former Fox's Howl editor. Main came to Silverton to see old friends on the evening of Nov. 29, 1978. In an interview with Main, he was asked about his memories of SUHS. He stated, "I liked Silverton probably because of all the crazy stunts like B.B. gun fights with Allan Renback. "We decided to quit them when someone got hurt. We decided that wasn't the thing to do."



He also remembers he stayed away from the police station as much as possible. "It's really hard to be the police chief's son."

"Some of the teachers I remember were Bill Iron, Ron Hite, Richard Unger and I have very warm memories of Charlie McNatt and Cordell Woodall."

Main says he had fun working on the Fox's Howl. "I especially liked it because I could leave the high school frequently. I liked working under a deadline, the pressure of knowing you have to have your stories in on a certain day."

When asked if he thinks high school kids have changed much, he said, "The life styles have. Grown-ups say the same things now that they said when I was in school. The young people are learning more things faster."

Getting to the subject of his career, Main said that "You have to enjoy what you're doing at the time you're doing it." Main feels that his drama teacher, Bill Iron, was a great inspiration to him.

When asked when he decided he wanted to be an actor, he stated, "I don't know. I liked to dress up in costumes and pretend a lot. I was also impressed by things I saw in films."

He acted at the University of Oregon. He played with the idea of acting for four years. Main has acted in 25 feature films and lots of TV. He also acted in plays in high school.

"I had a job once working for a radio station called KPMX-FM, the first underground radio station, in the 1960's," said Main.

Asked if he has ever turned down jobs, Main replied "Yes, I have. I've turned down jobs for lack of quality. It's never wrong to turn down something that is wrong."

During the '60's Main became very involved in politics. Many things were happening in his life. His friends were dying in Vietnam and from drugs. It was a very trying time for him.

"My work day is from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. We discuss it Monday and then rehearse," said Main.

Concerning living locations he said, "I prefer to live in San Francisco, but I have to work in LA. I just enjoy working too much."

When asked what his most memorable part was he said, "I like doing Dr. Johnny Fever. I like working week to week."

What brought Main back to Oregon? "Well, there are three reasons; KEX radio asked me to do a radio show; I wanted to see old friends; and I also wanted to take a trip with my mom," he said.

"I'm really glad I was here. I have pleasant memories of Silverton."

Will he ever live in Silverton again? "Fate can do anything. After all, look what it's done so far," said Main.

After talking to Butch Main on the phone and then in person, I discovered I was calling him Butch instead of Howard Hesseman. He is a very nice guy and easy to get along with. I found myself talking to him as an ex-Silvertonian instead of an actor.

I was very impressed by him. He really thinks a lot of his mother and of his old friends. I feel that he also thinks a lot of everyone he meets. It was probably my most memorable experience. He just really made me feel at home and I'm glad I had a chance to meet him.

If some of you haven't seen his show and like good comedy shows, I do suggest you watch WKRP. You won't be sorry.

"If I have left anyone out or didn't really remember someone, I really apologize," said Main.

BUTCH WAS VERY DOWN TO EARTH. I love that he kept in touch with a group of classmates clear up until he died. He was always a hometown boy at heart. When you meet him and talk, he no longer seems like someone famous.

I wrote to him a few times after the interview. He always answered and asked how I was doing. I was sad to hear about his passing. The world lost a wonderful person.

Editor's note: Howard (Butch Main) Hesseman passed away suddenly following colon surgery on January 29, 2022. We are aware that many of our readers knew Butch. The preceding story was copied from the Fox's Howl student newspaper. Many of us watched the comedy show where he performed as a disc jockey, Dr. Johnny Fevera very funny, entertaining person.


