

Fifty Years Since Title IX

On June 23, 1972 Richard Nixon signed into law the Bill that opened the door for many young women to compete in organized athletics. The Bill, known as Title Nine, is also known as the 'Patsy Takemoto Mink Equal Opportunity in Education Act'. (Patsy Mink was a Representative from Hawaii and it is notable to note that Edith Green, a Representative from Oregon, worked tirelessly with her to get this Bill passed through Congress.) What this did for women's athletics across the nation is reflected in our own local athletics. Our Silverton women have been involved in athletics for many years as is noted in the March 2, 1994 edition of the Silverton Appeal with a photo of the 1910 women's basketball team. In looking through my great aunt's, (Winona Palmer Hatteberg) Oregon Agricultural College scrapbook, there are several photos of the winning 1914 Silverton girls' basketball team, of which she was a member. After graduating high school she went on to play basketball for OAC. Many of our young women athletes have also gone on to play successfully at the college level. However, in

my great aunt's days there was

no Title Nine and that is evident in the fact that the girls did not play at the high school as the men did; they played in the old Opera House which was located at the corner of North Water and Oak Street.

Our Silverton High School women athletes have always distinguished themselves in many sports even before Title Nine. Silverton had a very successful girl's track team that placed 2nd



in District competition in 1971. (Silvertonia, pages 166-167). A lot has changed since Title Nine and in the 1975 Silvertonia. 'Girls' athletic competition at Silverton this fall was expanded.' (Pages 142-143). That year the gymnastics and volleyball teams totaled 36 girls and were coached by Debbie Brandes and Jim Bingham respectively. Then during the 1976-1977 academic school year women's sports added basketball. Coaching the team was Jim Brueckner. That first team ever to compete in league competition closed their

season with a 51-41 win over St. Helens. Under the direction of coach Brueckner that was a year of skill building and learning basketball fundamentals. With that humble beginning, women's sports at Silverton High School began to grow and expand.

A few short years of 'skill building and learning basketball fundamentals' found our young women taking home the state championship in basketball. The

front page of the Silverton Appeal, March 15, 1989, shows a jubilant team celebrating their first place accomplishment with trophy in hand. To add to our women basketball teams accomplishments they once again took the state 3A championship in 1994.

Once again our women were celebrated on the front page of the Silverton Appeal of March 16, 1994 with trophy on hand. Without Title Nine our women would not have been given the benefit of equal treatment that has led our women teams to excellence, not in just basketball, but in all sports. Silverton women have excelled in every area of athletics and most recently the Dance Team has won the 5A State Dance Team Championship!



How Can I be a Class Representative?

We are often asked about the list of Class Reps in the back of the newsletter. "What do I have to do?" is the most common question.

Relax - there are no "duties". A Class Representative is mainly a contact person for a designated class year.

We would presume that person would be keeping track of classmates in order to make preparations for a reunion at 5, 10 or 20 years. The more often you have a reunion, the easier it is to keep track of everyone.

It's a great help when the Class Rep is notified by anyone who moves or changes his/her name. And some classes have better luck than others.

In addition to editing the newsletter, I also keep the Alumni database up to date. The Class Reps help by sending me the changes of address for their classmates. This is a constant job. I am always receiving Emails with address changes.

Reunion Preparation:

Most reunions are held after a 5-year period (5, 10, 15, 20, etc.). Each year we concentrate on whatever year ends in a 5-year period from the date of graduation. For instance, for 2022 we mailed complimentary copies of the newsletter to all classes ending in 7 and 2.

Both this newsletter and the June (2023) issue will be sent to those classes ending in 3 and 8. Contact us if your class will have a reunion in 2023.

Let this be a "heads up" to *you*. Start working on your mailing list now. We suggest you begin with a list from the Alumni Association. Request a class roster, compare it

with what information you currently have, and work from there. The Post Office does not forward our newsletters. If one is sent out with a bad address (i.e., to someone who has moved), the newsletter is returned to us at a cost of 67¢. If the move has been within the past six months, the Post Office will provide us with a current address. Many times, however, we pay for the return only to get it stamped with "Moved - No Forwarding Address" or "FOE" (Forwarding order expired).
