

Alumni Spotlight: The Jack Hande Story By John & Carmen Smith

Early Years.

Jack is a descendant of early settlers, the Bagbys who came west in 1852. The family moved to Silverton from Hillsboro in 1931 when Jack was 6 months old. They operated the Handy Variety Store from 1930 until 1943, and from 1949 to 1981 they owned and ran the Carl Hande Hardware Store in the Wolf Building at the corner of Main and Water Street.

Jack attended Eugene Field School from the 1st through 8th grades and went to Silverton Union High School where he graduated in 1949.

Silverton High School – Class of '49

Jack was an outstanding athlete who played varsity football, baseball and basketball.

In his senior year he was a high scoring forward who was named a first string Willamette Valley League All Star. His teammates honored him by voting him "Most Inspirational Player."

He served on the Student Council and was president of Plentis Vitas in his senior year. This organization was responsible for entertaining skits presented at pep assemblies.

Post High School.

After high school Jack attended Willamette University where he played varsity baseball and basketball and graduated with a BA in 1953. He served in the Army and had the privilege of playing on their baseball team. Later Jack played for the Silverton Red Sox and other semi-pro baseball teams.



Silverton Teacher 1957-1961

Jack accepted a teaching position at Silverton Union High School. He was at the school the same years as the class of '61 many of whom considered him one of their favorite teachers and mentors.

He taught Basic Math, Algebra, Geometry and Biology. Jack had a great sense of humor and his classes were always fun.

In addition to academics Jack served as a baseball and

basketball coach and Sight, Sound and Service (SSS) advisor.

After Teaching/Present

Jack left Silverton for a teaching position in Salem.

After retiring from teaching he owned and managed a sporting goods store in Salem and then had a third career as a builder. His most popular sporting goods was skis and other equipment you had to have.

Jack currently lives in West Salem with his adorable wife, Kay.

Although he is "retired" Jack remains very active in the Silverton community where according to Our Town he "is regarded by many as something of a town treasure for his interest in finding and preserving memories of Silverton's bygone days." He has been a huge contributor to the Silverton Historical Society and has published a number of small booklets filled with stories about the Silverton area.

Class Challenge

Many components go into the growing of the SHS Alumni Association Scholarship fund. The newest is the Class Challenge which was started six years ago when the Class of 1959 challenged other classes to help raise money for scholarships. That year, several classes took up the challenge and raised \$3,400. In the following years more and more Alumni and their classes took up the Challenge which resulted in more money being raised for Scholarships. This activity allowed us to continue to raise money for scholarships even when the annual fundraiser event was cancelled due to the Pandemic in 2020 and 2021. Since 2017, the SHSAA Class Challenge has raised \$217,845 for scholarships.

This year we had 29 classes participate in the 2023 Class Challenge by donating a total of \$51,782 to the Challenge. It was a close race between the second and third place classes. The Class of 1967 won first place with total donations in the amount of \$16,025. The Class of 1960 won second place by raising \$10,800 and the Class of 1961 won third place by raising \$10,058 in the 2023 Class Challenge. SHSAA will be awarding Class Challenge scholarships in 2024 to three graduating seniors under the name of the Class of 1967 for \$1,000. Class of 1960 for \$750 and Class of 1961 for \$500. Thank you to everyone who donated to the Challenge this year.

The 2024 Class Challenge is officially open now so make your donations early and get your classmates to participate. It's so easy, just write a check and use the form on this page or make a payment on our website. Just a reminder, Dues, Memorial and other designated donations will not be included in the Class Challenge. All donations must be received in our office by Thursday August 1st in order to be included in the 2024 Class Challenge.

If you are required to take a distribution from your IRA this year, you may want to consider a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) donation to the SHSAA 2024 Class Challenge. You can donate directly from a taxable IRA instead of taking the required minimum distributions, which can lower your taxable income. Contact your IRA custodian or tax advisor for details.
